Voluntary Action Highland (VAH) is a charitable company limited by guarantee set up as a constituted body in 1996 and incorporated as a company in 2004.

Its Mission Statement:

Voluntary Action Highland's mission is to provide information and support to Highland wide Voluntary Organisations while offering strategic services to the Highland Regional Council for Voluntary Services and championing positive communication between the voluntary, statutory and private sectors.

Its Objects are:

- a) to promote any charitable purpose for the benefit of the community in Highland and in particular, the advancement of education, the protection of health and the relief of poverty, sickness and distress
- b) to promote and organise co-operation in the achievement of the above purposes and to that end to bring together in council representatives of voluntary organisations and statutory authorities.

In furtherance of those objects the company has the power to provide services of a council for voluntary service including development, support and representation.
